### EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

The Yellowknives Dene First Nation (YKDFN) is governed by a Chief and Council which has offices in Dettah and Ndilo. The YKDFN Chiefs and Council affirm our sacred obligation to serve our people and our commitment to live balanced contemporary lifestyles with culture and traditions important to our community, to speak our traditional language and to protect our natural resources and treaty rights. For Chiefs and Council to lead the YKDFN requires having qualified personnel to achieve a prosperous future for our citizens. The incumbent works within this context to provide effective and efficient level of support and assistance.

#### **Regulatory Specialist**

Under the authority of the Yellowknives Dene First Nation Government Chiefs and Council and under the direct supervision of the Director, Environment, the Regulatory Specialist is responsible for managing, reviewing, and coordinating the response to all regulatory matters related to mineral exploration in the YKDFN's Traditional Territory. The Regulatory Specialist is responsible for coordinating all consultation and engagement activities and relevant duties arising from the YKDFN's participation in regulatory proceedings that have the potential to affect the YKDFN's rights and title. This position is located in the community of Ndilo, Monday to Friday, with visits to Dettah.

#### **The qualifications required for this position:**

- Degree in environmental science or engineering with two to five years of related experience in conducting in-depth regulatory, environmental scientific and technical reviews. Equivalencies will be considered.
- Knowledge of environmental regulations.
- Project management of environmental programs.
- Knowledge in the field of environmental assessment and/or environmental regulation.
- Ability to deal with difficult situations (involving conflicting ideas) in a tactful manner.
- Experience in northern developments would be considered a definite asset.
- Preference will be given to Yellowknives Dene First Nations members.
